Meeting opened with the Our Father

Minutes from the meeting on August 16, 2018, were approved with a motion by John and a second by Eddie.

OLD BUSINESS:

Principal's Report – Question was raised as to why the School did not raise lunch prices for the last two years and we were required to move funds totaling \$3,400 to the school lunch program to be in Compliance with Federal regulations. This appeared in an audit this spring and the School needed to make corrections.

Choice Wine – While the program is good, only 8 couples are participating in Boonville and 4-5 in Fayette. Attendance is at about 60%

Connie Gerling will be leading the Public Square Prayer Rosary Rally on Saturday, October 14, 2018 at Hannah Cole Park while Theresa Krebs will have a booth at the Blackwater Festival.

Brian Lutz reported that they have 16-18 kids every Sunday night in their Program.

NEW BUSINESS

Lillian informed us of the Merida Foundation at St. Peter's Parish in Jefferson City where they collect glasses for Mexico. It was agreed that we would put a basket in the vestibule of Church to help St. Peter's Parish.

Father introduced the Wichita Plan which he would like to include in our Parish, a Stewardship Program not only geared to tithing but time and talent as well. With the Mission of the Parish, we would someday like to be in a position to provide more services to parishioners, increase attendance and instill a new buoyancy into our church.

The name of the School will be changed to SS. Peter and Paul Parish School and a letter will be going out to those families in our school that are not attending Mass and contributing stating they will no longer get free tuition and will have to become tuition paying families. The letter will go out the first of November and they will have until December 1 to decide if they want to start coming to Church and tithing or become a tuition family.

The next meeting is November 15, 2018.
