

**2019 Confirmation Agreement  
SS Peter and Paul - Boonville**

I, \_\_\_\_\_, wish to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. In entering this agreement, I acknowledge that I will have expectations set forth by the Diocese of Jefferson City, my Parish Priest, and Confirmation Team. I will put forth my best effort to present myself as an active adult Catholic. Confirmation is my opportunity to strengthen my faith and to become an active adult member of my church.

Some of my requirements are, but are not limited to:

- **Attend Confirmation classes** held as scheduled. School and other activities sometimes conflict with attendance, but every effort should be made to attend. Late arrival is more beneficial than missing entirely. A system is in place to make up missed classes, but the program is student-driven and discussion-based so a large piece is missing if I do not attend.
- **Participate in class.** The meetings offer the opportunity to learn more about my faith by participating in the discussions. I may not have the right answer, but I may help to find it.
- **Regularly attend Mass.** An active member of the Catholic Church attends Mass weekly (Saturday evening or Sunday) and on Holy Days, predominately in his/her parish. Fr. Bill would like to briefly meet with me in the Cry Room after each Mass.
- **Be active in my church, community, and school.** Service is necessary. A number of group projects will be organized. These will include the Parish Turkey Dinner on Nov. 3rd and three others. Participation in all of the group activities will accumulate all of the required points. If I am unable to attend all of the group events, a series of smaller group, and/or individual events may be credited. However, I am expected to participate in a minimum of two group projects.
- **Choose a sponsor** to help me along my journey. The sponsor *must be at least 16 years of age, may not be one of my parents, must regularly attend Mass and be active in his/her parish.* The sponsor should attend classes with me, help guide me in my decisions, and support me on my journey. If my chosen sponsor is not able to attend classes and events, I can select a proxy to help me along my journey when the primary sponsor cannot.
- **Choose a Confirmation name.** There are many ways to decide on a Confirmation name. I will have discussions, research saints, and find a name that best fits me. I will write a paragraph about why I picked this saint.
- **Attend a Catholic-based retreat, camp, or conference.** I will attend a Catholic-based retreat, camp or conference. There are many options listed on the Diocese's website at <https://www.oymdiojeffcity.com/youth-programs>. Detailed information about camps will be provided.
- **Write a letter to the Bishop** explaining why I want to be confirmed and how I will live as an active Catholic. I will receive instruction and guidance throughout the Confirmation sessions to assist me.
- **I understand that once the date is set by the Bishop for confirmation, it is a priority. The date for confirmation has been set. It is: Monday, November 18 at 7 p.m.**

I have read my Confirmation agreement, asked questions as needed, and fully understand what I am undertaking. I choose to be confirmed in the Catholic faith, and I agree to fulfill my responsibilities to the best of my ability.
