### Dates, Deadlines and Dollars

- **DATES:** July 12-14, 2019. Our weekend host will be Dan Harms. Our worship leader will be Josh Blakesley. Our speakers will include Fr. Mike Schmitz, Katie Prejean McGrady, David Calavitta and Noelle Garcia. More information about the conference is available at <https://steubystl.com>.
- **COST:** \$200 per person (includes \$190 registration fee and \$10 transportation fee). The fee includes Friday dinner through Sunday breakfast. We stay in dorm housing at MSU. (Dorms have two twin beds. Three people will be in each room; this includes chaperones and young adults. Males and females are housed in separate buildings.)
- **Deposit Due Date:** \$50 non-refundable deposit is due by February 15, 2019 to the parish office.
- **Remaining Balance Due:** April 30, 2019

### Participant Categories

- **TEEN PARTICIPANTS:** Participants may range from incoming freshmen (entering 9th grade in August of 2019) through graduated seniors (graduated in May of 2019).
- **YOUNG ADULTS:** Individuals between the ages of 18 and 21 and past the summer after their senior year of high school. There can be no more than one young adult for every 10 teen participants.
- **CHAPERONES:** Parish Youth Ministers, Trish and Brian Lutz; Kelly and Jesse Rohrbach; and DRE, Theresa Krebs. If additional chaperones are needed, information will be communicated. Chaperones must be 21 years of age and in compliance with the Diocesan Child Protection Policies. Chaperones should be prepared and able to walk long distances across campus, handle loud music in the sessions and keep up with active youth. The Office of Youth Ministry requires one chaperone for every eight youth, per gender.
